# **VISITOR GUIDELINES**

We are excited to welcome you to campus so you can see first-hand what it is like to be a Captain! To ensure the health and safety of our community and visitors, we have added the following guidelines based on recommendations from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Virginia Department of Public Health (VDH).

## **BEFORE YOUR VISIT**

We strongly encourage all visitors to register in advance of arriving on campus. We may not be able to immediately accommodate walk-in visitors due to physical distancing guidelines and other health safety protocol.

## **CHECK FOR COVID-19 SYMPTOMS**

We ask that you check for the following COVID-19 symptoms before visiting campus:

- Fever
- Cough
- Difficulty getting air
- Loss of smell or taste
- Sore throat
- Muscle aches

Please notify the Office of Admission and reschedule your visit if:

- You or your guest(s) exhibit any symptoms
- You or your guest(s) have recently been in contact with someone who has contracted COVID-19
- You or your guest(s) have been directed by a school official or healthcare provider to isolate, quarantine or get tested for COVID-19

Please refrain from visiting for at least 10 days after a positive test, and until you test negative.

## **ON THE DAY OF YOUR VISIT**

Face coverings are no longer required in shared indoor spaces. Anyone is free to wear a mask for health reasons or as a preference to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 and other infectious diseases.

Any updated health safety protocol details will be included in your confirmation emails.

We strongly encourage you to follow public health guidelines, including washing your hands or using hand sanitizer. We have suspended our beverage station, so please bring your own beverage.

We are taking all currently recommended precautions but we cannot eliminate the risk of COVID-19 exposure. Please remember that you are visiting campus at your own risk.
